Yn 2020 gwnaethom gyhoeddi strategaeth newydd, [Dewis i Bawb](#), gan nodi ein hymrwymiad i gynyddu argaeledd cymwysterau cyfrwng Cymraeg.

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Dros y flwyddyn ddiwethaf rydym wedi bod yn datblygu [canllawiau](#) i'ch cefnogi i ddatblygu, darparu a dyfarnu cymwysterau cyfrwng Cymraeg. Heddiw rydym yn lansio'r canllaw cynhwysfawr hwn a gynlluniwyd i annog a chefnogi pob corff dyfarnu, p'un a ydych yn dechrau datblygu cymwysterau cyfrwng Cymraeg am y tro cyntaf, neu eisiau dysgu o arferion da, neu wella mewn rhai meysydd. Regulatory Policy Update

We would like to update you on a suite of guidance that we have published and is now available on our [website](#). The guidance is designed to support you in complying with a range of Standard Conditions of Recognition and with developing and delivering Welsh-medium qualifications.

Guidance to support awarding body compliance

We carried out a review of the Standard Conditions of Recognition and published revised Conditions that came into force from 1 October 2020. Awarding bodies told us that as well as revising the wording of the Conditions, guidance would also be helpful to support ongoing compliance.

We held a series of webinars with awarding bodies throughout 2020-21 and received useful feedback which we have incorporated into the final versions. We have published a suite of [guidance](#) on the following Conditions:

Condition A4: Conflicts of Interest

Condition A6: Contingency Planning

Condition A8: Malpractice and Maladministration

Condition D6: Management of the Change in Status of Qualifications or Withdrawal of Qualifications

Condition E10: Recognition of Prior Learning

Condition F1: Information on Fees of Qualifications

Guidance on Welsh-Medium Qualifications

In 2020 we published a new strategy, [Choice for All](#), setting out our commitment to increasing the availability of Welsh-medium qualifications.

Over the last year we have been developing [guidance](#) to support you with the development, delivery and awarding of Welsh- medium qualifications. Today we are launching this comprehensive guide designed to encourage and support all awarding bodies, whether you are starting to develop Welsh-medium qualifications for the first time, or want to learn from good practice, or improve in certain areas.

The guidance also contains useful references and links to resources and further guidance for those who want to learn more.

The guidance goes through the lifecycle of developing, delivering, awarding and certifying a qualification and in particular covers areas such as the following:

- Identifying opportunities in the system and prioritising qualifications;
- The 'Active Offer' and a learner-centred approach;
- Forward planning with centres about their language needs;
- Good practice examples when procuring and managing translation;
- Ensuring the quality of Welsh-medium assessment materials;
- Use of technology in Welsh-medium assessments; and
- Reasonable adjustments and adapting assessments for learners completing them in Welsh.

We engaged with a wide range of awarding bodies and stakeholders in developing this guidance, including a Subject Expert Advisory Group, which included many key organisations working in bilingual and multilingual assessment across Wales and internationally. In particular, we would like to thank all members of the Awarding Body Welsh Language Support Group who contributed to developing this guidance and especially those of you who contributed case studies. If you would also like your organisation to join this group, then please get in touch.

Regulatory Welsh-Medium Qualifications Policy

Alongside the guidance, the Regulatory Welsh-Medium Qualifications Policy has been reviewed and is being revised to align with our [Choice for All](#) strategy and [Qualified for the Future](#) work. This is also due to be published shortly.
